Seems silly doesn't it, yet people fall for it! In fact, people fall for everything but the obvious. And the obvious is that GOD is the source of ALL POWER! King David.. the greatest King of all time understood the power of God. He prayed as recorded in 1 Chronicles 29...

The lady said she was mountain climbing and came to a difficult ledge. She pulled the rope a little too taunt and it hit her in the eye, popping out one of her contact lens.

Remembering the verse that says...

'The eyes of God go to and fro throughout the whole earth' she prayed...

"God, from your vantage point, you can see exactly

where the contact is...so please help me find it." She looked around. Every drop of water and every glistening rock looked like the lens, but it was nowhere to be found. Disappointed, she began the descent down the mountain. As she was climbing down, a friend was climbing up and hollered... "Hey, anyone lose a contact? There's an ant carrying it down the mountain".
It came special delivery for her – from a hard working ant.
She said it was as if God had given her a big hug and said
"My precious daughter, I care about every detail of your life".
