INTRO: A father wanted to teach his young son about the value of reading the Bible repeatedly, so he took a DIRTY basket, punched HOLES in the bottom of it, and had his son go with him to the river. There he instructed him to dip the basket in the water and draw it out. The boy obeyed, and...of course...the water poured through the holes. He had him repeat this three times – with the same results. Then he asked the boy..."What do you see?" The boy responded, "It's clean!". "That's just it", the father said. "The more you read the Bible, the cleaner you get!" Today on Grace Notes, Barbara Sandbek will talk about the Power that comes from the TRUTH of the Word of God – so stay tuned!

That was a pretty ingenious way for the father to teach that valuable lesson to his son, wasn't it? No doubt, he knew Hebrews 4:12, which says...

The Word of God is living and active, sharper than any double-edged sword. It penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

God's Word acts as a powerful cleansing agent.

I picture my walk with the Lord as a fine-tuned engine. When I maintain my spirit through Bible study, prayer and meditation, it purrs. I can easily avoid the pitfalls the devil throws in my way, be at peace with life's interruptions, and get great mileage from the fruits of the spirit. But, when I try to live on yesterday's fuel, I find the fumes are not enough to sustain me. No maintenance – no POWER!

Just think what we could accomplish in our day, if we fueled up before we started it!

The POWER to live successfully comes from learning and applying the truths of the Bible, on a DAILY basis.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 says...

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness; that the man of God may be PERFECT, THOROUGHLY FURNISHED unto all good works.

God's Word is the common language between God and us.

We use a lot of Scripture in our concerts. After one of our services, a lady said that she'd been crying during the concert, though she wasn't particularly sad or happy. At first she couldn't understand why, but then she thought of how we feel when we're away from home and nothing is familiar. Then when we're around something that reminds us of home, we might shed a tear. She thought of the Holy Spirit, all bottled up inside us humans. When He hears something familiar, like God's Word, He sheds tears through us!

The Holy Spirit in us longs to communicate to the Father in our behalf, in the language He understands. When we're in His Word, we'll find that our fellowship is sweeter.

God's Word is like a lighthouse.

The book of 2 Peter, warns us against false teachers who secretly introduce destructive heresies. It says..."In their greed, these teachers will exploit you with stories they have made up".

Jesus, said in Matthew 7:15...

Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves. By their fruit you will recognize them.

But will we recognize them? Do we know what the fruits are and how they're manifested?

2 Timothy 2:15 says...Study to show thyself approved unto God - a workman that needs not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth.

God gave us His Word to read. It doesn't enter our brain through osmosis. We have a responsibility, as Believers, to do our part so we're not deceived.

The Psalmist wrote in Psalm 119:105...

Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path.

A friend of mine and I were having lunch together. Since we always discuss spiritual things, I had my Bible and some note paper with me. The Bible was on my lap with the paper on top of it. I was talking about a decision I had to make, and, lifting up the paper I said..."If only God would just write the answer right here for me". I stopped, looked down at my Bible and said..."Oh, He did didn't He - it's in the Book". The Bible does have the answer for every decision we need to make. We just need to read it!

**** **THY WORD** ***

When Kev was small, he took Karate lessons. I did, too, just to have something to do while I waited for him. The instructor talked about the power you could have over your opponent by knowing the moves. But, it all boiled down to the fact, that as long as you knew more than your opponent, you were safe.

When Jesus' opponent, satan, tempted Him at His lowest point, after forty days of fasting, He didn't try to reason with him, rather He used the greatest defensive move there is - God's Word. Jesus knew the power that came from the Scriptures. If it worked for Jesus, you bet it will work for you!

The Psalmist stated in Psalm 119:11...

Thy Word have I hid in my heart that I might not sin against Thee.

We need to KNOW God's Word...in order to HIDE it...in order to USE it. It alone, gives us power over evil. Dale & I met a zealous evangelist once and asked where he got his zeal. He told us that he'd memorized hundreds of verses. Everything reminded him of a Scripture. When we asked what things discouraged him, he told us that he never got discouraged because the Scripture would constantly minister to him. Want a cure for depression? Try memorizing Scripture.

Maybe you're listening today and saying...I don't get a thing out of the Bible, so how can studying it give me power? First, I want to say that you won't understand it unless you have the Holy Spirit inside you through belief in Christ. Ask Jesus to come into you life today and save you from your sin. Then the Holy Spirit will illumine your mind and enable you to understand these spiritual things.

Second, even after you're born of the Spirit, you won't understand unless you really want to. I learned a lot of Bible verses when I was young, but I didn't appropriate them. There was a point in my life, though, when I said..."I know there has to be more to Christianity than what I'm giving it. I'm going to pray and read the Bible, whether I understand it or not". I made a concerted effort, and God has rewarded me with an understanding of and a love for His Word.

Reading God's Word BUILDS OUR FAITH.

Romans 10:17 states...

Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

Reading God's Word GIVES US HOPE.

Romans 15:4 says...

Everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have HOPE.

I'd like to close now with two songs I learned when I was growing up that speak of the precious treasure we have in the POWERFUL Word of God.
