INTRO: Welcome to Grace Notes.

Our Heavenly Father desires to do the same with the gifts He gives. He gave His best when He sent us Jesus to pay the penalty for our sin. There was no price tag that could be put on His life. James 1:17a states that every good and perfect gift is from above and comes down from the Father of heavenly lights. Jesus is the perfect gift and He gave to us the fruit of the spirit through the Holy Spirit because He is a good Father and desires to delight us.

Today, on Grace Notes we will cover several other gifts under the tree. This is the last program in our Christmas tree series. Have you started making your ornaments? Time's awastin'.

I see another gift on the tree. It's GOODNESS.

The only GOOD in this world is because GOD is GOOD.

Phil 1:6 says...

We can rest assured that He who began a GOOD work in you, will perform it unto the day of Jesus Christ.

God begins the work when we receive Jesus' free gift of salvation. He works in our hearts as we live out our faith, to help us bring Glory to Himself and enjoy an abundant life. His promises throughout His Word assure us that He will be with

us now and through eternity. Psalm 23:6 states..

Surely, GOODNESS and mercy will FOLLOW me all the days of my life and I will dwell in the house of the Lord, FOREVER!!!

God had Isaiah foretell Jesus Christ's coming 700 years before it can to be. He also prophesied His death in great detail. You can read about it in Isaiah chapter 53.

You see, Jesus came to DIE - so we could LIVE forever.

God has GOOD PLAN for us – a plan to make us more like CHRIST to be able to rule and reign with Him.

Oh, I just found another great gift – this is exciting. I love presents!

This gift says MEEKNESS. It is defined as...

Matt. 11:29-30 Jesus said...

Do people feel comfortable approaching You?

Jesus came here as a baby not a king. Everyone loves a baby.

He felt all we feel and more.

He showed us that we can approach Him because He understands.

GENTLENESS goes along with the gift of Long-suffering, or patience, which is the epitome of Christian maturity.

James 2:4 says...

Let patience have her perfect work, that you may be perfect and entire, (mature & complete) wanting(lacking) nothing.

In Eph. 4:1-2 Paul puts them altogether...

I beseech you that you walk worthy of the vocation wherewith you are called, with all lowliness and meekness, with long-suffering, forbearing one another in love (that's patience), endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

These gifts or fruits pave the way for the gift of TEMPERANCE, or self-control. That should really be God control - willing to do whatever He wants - the way He wants.

Paul wrote in Phil 2:4-8...

Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of other. Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus. Who being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God but made Himself of no reputation, and took upon Him the form of a servant and was made in the likeness of men. And being found in fashion as a man He humbled Himself and became obedient unto death, even the death of the Cross. (Christ set the example.)

We're not necessarily called to die on a cross – but we are called to die to ourselves.

Mary did when she said...

"I am the Lord's servant... May it be to me as you have said".

Mary's unquestioning obedience to the Lord gave eternal blessings to all.

Who knows what can be accomplished in our lives if we're willing to submit to God the way Mary did.

Think of the blessing Mary would have missed if she had said 'No'.

Christ came to give gifts that keep on giving...

Fruit left on the tree rots. It benefits no one.

The Fruit of the Spirit only operates in our lives as we pull it from our heart vine and give it out.
